	Drug Trafficking Routes - coming from China and India; through Chicago to Grand Rapids up to our area in Traverse City, and through Detroit to the U.P. The Mexican Cartel is bringing drugs into the U.S. through the Southwest border of Mexico. They are making their way into our neighborhoods. The cartels are currently operating in Michigan.	
	 Drug seizures US Customs and Border Protection officers discovered more than \$10 million worth of narcotics in a jalapeno paste shipment on December 14, 2023. Bay County Deputies find 3,000 Fentanyl pills after traffic stop in September 2023. Police seize 2K+ Fentanyl pills disguised as Adderall from Sterling Heights home.
