4:10pm	Drug Trends	Current local and national drug trends Kip Belcher works for the Michigan State Police and oversees the narcotic teams in Northern Michigan Counterfeit Pills are a rising concern, may contain meth and lethal amounts of fentanyl. If tablets are cracked, crumbly, have worn edges, or lack detail, they may be counterfeit. Oxycodone is the most common counterfeit tablet is Xanax bars. Adderall is the third most common counterfeit pill. Of special note regarding trends, marijuana arrests and seizures have decreased in the past with a slight increase in 2022, most likely due to the legalization for both medical and recreational use. 		 marijuana distribution and sales continue to be a concern in Michigan. Narcotics related overdoses in Michigan increased 2019-2021. In 2022 there was an upward trend, but the first three months of 2023 is trending downward. Most narcotics processed by MSP labs are polysubstance submissions meaning they have more than one substance in one submission which are accounting for new/novel drugs. Xylazine, a non-controlled veterinary sedative is being added to heroin/fentanyl mixtures. Medetomidine has been identified by MSP labs as being present with Xylazine and is only approved by the FDA for animal use. These substances are not responsive to Naloxone. Meth continues to make its way across the southern border. Included are slides for information in charts and graphs, such as opioid only deaths, drug trafficking routes, 7th District incidents, and incidents by County.
